These are the three common symptoms of Coronavirus infection, although there are less common symptoms that may present themselves as illustrated in this diagram.

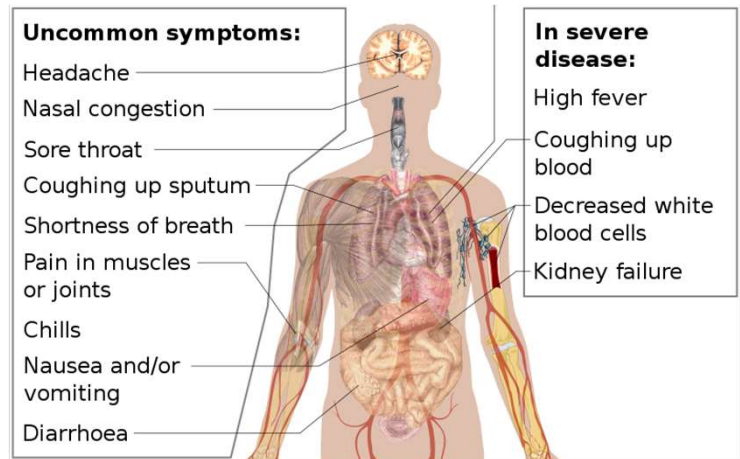
